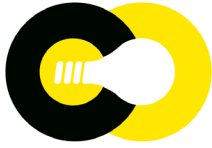


HEARING CONSERVATION



The Center for Disease Control (CDC) estimates that

22 million workers are exposed to potentially damaging noise at work each year.

OSHA requires employers to implement a hearing conservation program when noise exposure is at or above 85 decibels averaged over 8 working hours, or an 8-hour time-weighted average (TWA). Hearing conservation programs strive to prevent initial occupational hearing loss, preserve, and protect remaining hearing, and equip workers with the knowledge and hearing protection devices necessary to safeguard themselves.

Baseline Noise Monitoring Survey

Life and Safety will conduct a baseline noise survey to determine which areas / job tasks may be included in the hearing conservation program. The survey will outline where hearing protection is recommended and/or required and what levels of hearing protection should be offered. Conclusions and recommendations will be included in a written report.
